Students entering Year 10 (2025) or Year 11 (2025) who are not currently enrolled at the College are invited to apply for the Monte Sant' Angelo Mercy College Senior School Scholarship.

Applicants are also asked to provide further information in relation to their academic interests and pursuits. Statements should be no longer than one A4 page in length.

### **Section 2 – Extra-Curricular Profile**

A statement detailing the applicant's extra-curricular involvement and interests at their current school, as well as outside school activities (e.g. Sport, Music, the Arts, Debating, Language/Cultural Exchange). Please include reference to involvement in school service and community service in the statement that is no longer than one A4 page in length.

### **Section 3 – Applicant's Learner Profile**

All students from Years 7 to 10 at Monte Sant' Angelo Mercy College undertake a course of study that meets the requirements of both the NSW Education Standards Authority (NESA) and the International Baccalaureate Middle Years Programme (IB MYP). IB MYP students strive to develop 10 key learner attributes that are valued by all IB World Schools. Applicants may recognise a number of attributes that they value as a student and that have developed in them over time. The 10 attributes are listed in the IB Learner Profile document found on page 5 of this application.

For each of the **THREE** attributes chosen, a response in 200 words or less should be offered, outlining how they have demonstrated the attribute in their learning to date, referencing specific example(s).

The applicant is to write a personal statement discussing how they believe they will benefit from and contribute to Monte Sant' Angelo Mercy College in their senior years. Please handwrite the personal statement which should be no longer than one A4 page in length.
