



THE COST OF EDUCATING A STUDENT AT MONTE SANT' ANGELO MERCY COLLEGE

GENERAL INFORMATION

The College Board sets school fee levels annually. These fees represent a portion of the annual cost of educating a single student. The balance of the cost is met by grants from the Commonwealth and State Governments. Tuition fees increase annually in line with the Board's Fees Policy and the College's long term financial model.

TUITION FEES

Tuition fees are incurred annually, but invoiced in four equal instalments at the beginning of each school term, except for Year 12, which is billed in three equal installments over the first three terms. Tuition fees cover costs such as tuition, resources and in-house excursions and activities. Tuition fees do not include uniforms, textbooks, sports and optional extra-curricular activities.

Tuition fees at the College in 2025	
Years 7 & 8	\$28,540 per annum
Years 9 & 10	\$29,620 per annum
Years 11 & 12	\$31,680 per annum

Sibling Discounts, early payment discounts and monthly payment plans are available.

iLearn PROGRAM CHARGE

Each student is issued with a notebook computer, software and access to full IT support. Families enter into an agreement with the College and pay a fee that covers access to the program, equipment, software and support.

ADDITIONAL STUDENT CHARGES

There are additional charges for a variety of camps, sports and extra-curricular activities. These are charged on a cost basis. Some of these are optional. The additional costs for these activities will therefore vary between students. The charges are added to the invoice for the term's tuition fees.

Examples (approximate cost only):	
Year 7 Camp	\$500
Netball Terms 2 & 3	\$400
Music Ensembles (eg Junior Choir)	\$375
Debating Competition	\$350
IB Examination Fees	\$1,200

Whilst tuition fees are not subject to GST some of the additional charges will incur this tax in accordance with Federal legislation.

COLLEGE BUILDING FUND

In addition to the compulsory charges, parents are urged to consider supporting the College Building Fund. Contributions are sought for this fund to enable the College to continue developing the best possible facilities to assist in the education of present and future students.
